

Registration & Requirements

1. Obtain Registration form by calling 614.995.0714 or on our website at <http://CollisionBoard.Ohio.Gov>
2. Remit \$225.00 annual registration fee
3. Submit your federal and state taxpayer identification numbers, valid vendor's license number, workers compensation and unemployment identification numbers.
4. Certificate of Insurance showing general liability and garage keeper coverage.
5. Include two (2) photographs; (1) Showing your building and its sign, (1) Displaying vehicle entrances and exits into your shop.

Registration exempted groups include: motor vehicle, auction and salvage dealers; fleet operators (these entities are already licensed under other specific state laws and governance); hobbyists repairing four or less motor vehicles in a calendar year.

Penalties

- Loss of Mechanics Lien rights.
- Fines of up to \$5,000
- Potential court-ordered business closure

The Ohio Board of Motor Vehicle Collision Repair Registration is a mandatory industry requested statewide program that protects the collision repair industry in Ohio.

Through your participation and registration, you exert control over and shape the future and prosperity of the collision repair industry in Ohio.

The Collision Repair Board is addressing critical issues such as falling net profits, aftermarket versus OEM parts usage, and a shrinking labor replacement pool.

All independent collision repair facilities, as of December 18, 1997, must register with the Ohio Board of Motor Vehicle Collision Repair Registration as per Ohio Revised Code 4775.



Shop owners across Ohio can now be instrumental in shaping, maintaining, and protecting the future of the collision repair industry in Ohio.
